

## Introduction to Tehran Province Society of Construction Technicians (TPSCT)

- TPSCT was established in accordance with the framework of engineering regulations and construction control under Iran's 1995 parliamentary act
- TPSCT's organizational code of conduct was approved by Iran's board of ministers in the year 2000
- The board of management are elected by TPSCT members and take responsibility as steering committee for a 3 year period
- TPSCT's board of directors consist of 4 individuals which are elected by the board of management on a yearly basis and are as follows: President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer
- Over the past six years, Mr. Mehdi Moazzen has been elected president of TPSCT and currently holds this position

### TPSCT's responsibilities and activities

- All individuals holding a higher diploma (technical technician) which have graduated in any of the five majors of construction including road & construction, architecture, electricity, mechanics and surveying are eligible for TPSCT membership
- Since currently experiential architects do not possess an organizational establishment, thus issues relating to their organization are carried out by TPSCT. Experiential architects are defined as building constructors with a long history of experience in construction; and whom can take out the majority of a building's construction job by themselves; and some which are currently engaged in the construction of community housing.
- Technicians of TPSCT currently consist of more than 4000 individuals
- Experiential architects associated with TPSCT currently consist of more than 5000 individuals

- TPCST currently has more than 9000 members consisting of technicians and experiential architects
- Since a considerable amount of construction jobs are carried out by technicians and experiential architects, thus organization, training and issuance of work permits for these individuals are carried out by TPCST
- It is worth noting that all mentioned matters are carried out under the supervision of Iran's ministry of housing and urban development

## TPSCT's Goals

- TPSCT strives to raise the quality of construction in Iran
- TPSCT strives to develop versatility between groups engaged in construction including engineers, technicians, experiential architects and skilled workers
- Holding educational courses with the goal of raising the technical knowledge of members
- Carrying out related exams and issuing of works permits for members. It is worth pointing out that all issued permits are signed by the representative of Iran's ministry of housing and urban development
- Supervision over construction to insure TPSCT members carry out responsibilities in a proper manner
- Exercising control over the use of standard material in order to increase safety and resistance of buildings
- TPSCT strives to make its members familiar with emerging technology and developed countries regarding the implementation of the latest methods in construction and the use of new and light weight building materials
